SHORT-TERM EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE TO RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS

AMP’s Project EASE (Energy Assistance through Supportive Efforts) provides short-term emergency assistance to residential customers who are unable to pay their electric bill and are at risk of having their power shut off.

HOUSEHOLD ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility for Project EASE is based on the customer’s gross income level and household size. The chart below will help you determine if you qualify.

To receive short-term assistance, you must have received a “notification of overdue payment” from AMP. Required ocumentation may include the following:

- CalFresh (food stamps)
- IRA/annuities
- SSI/SSDI/SSA
- W-2s
- CalWorks (cash aid)
- Retirement/Pension
- Unemployment Compensation
- Wages and/or income from self-employment
- General Assistance
- Spousal/Child Support
- Veteran’s Benefits
- Worker’s Compensation

- You will also need to show proof of identification for all adults and children under the age of 18 who are living in the house full time.
- Driver’s license must show service address or you will be required to submit a lease agreement, mortgage statement or property title.
